House rules

1- Smoker

The accommodation is non-smoking. Please kindly smoke on the balcony.

2- House Closing

Lock the doors, sliding doors, and windows when you leave the house during the day, and turn off the lights.

Be careful, once the door is slammed, you can only open it with the key. If the door is blocked any locksmith fees will be at your expense.

3- Noise

No excessive noise is allowed after 10:00 PM and before 8:00 AM. Of course, you can dine outside, but please avoid playing loud music to maintain the neighborhood's tranquility.

4- Keys

The keys must remain in your possession during your stay.

Key duplication is prohibited. Any key loss will result in a replacement fee of €100 for the travelers

5- Water

In case of water failure, you will find bottles of non-potable water under the sink.

6-Shower

The shower water may take a little time to heat up. Let it run and wait briefly.

7- Waste

Please sort your waste into the designated containers, separating common waste, plastic, cardboard, and glass. Do not leave garbage bags outside, as the neighbors' cats and dogs might tear them open and scatter the trash.

8- Barbecue

Please make sure to clean the barbecue grill after each use and empty the ashes into the designated container.

9- Pool

Caution: The pool depth is 1.70 meters. Do not leave children or non-swimmers unattended near the pool.
